Sex Offender Residence/Employer Proximity Form

On July 1, 2008, revisions to the Georgia Sex Offender Laws took effect. As you were previously advised, some changes affect your proximity to locations where children congregate and the annual re-registration requirement. The Glynn County Sheriff's Office will enforce the following revisions to the laws:

1. Sex offenders must register with the Sheriff of the County in which he/she will reside within **72 hours** after release from custody or being placed on probation, parole or supervised release or entry into the State. Homeless is not a valid address. **Violators will be arrested.**
2. Sex offenders **must renew** their required registration information **in person at the Sheriff's Office within 72 hours PRIOR** to their birthday each year and be photographed and fingerprinted.
3. A sex offender **Cannot Reside (42-1-15b) or Loiter(42-1-15e)** within 1,000 feet of any child care facility (As defined under **20-1A-2-4 Day-care Centers with License for 19 or more children under 18 years of age.**), church, school, or area where minors congregate to include public and private parks, recreation facilities, playgrounds, skating rinks, neighborhood centers, gymnasiums, beaches or public and community swimming pools and **public libraries (Added July 01, 2008).**
4. A sex offender that **OWNS** real property and resides on such property or has Established Employment at a location and one of the prohibited facilities or areas locates its self within 1,000 ft of such property the sex offender shall not be guilty of a violation of Subsection **42-1-15 b** or **c** if the sex offender had established **OWNERSHIP** or **EMPLOYMENT (42-1-15 f-1)** prior to July 01, 2006.
5. A sex offender cannot be Employed, **Volunteer (42-1-15 c1 Added July 01, 2008)** or Loiter (42-1-15 e) at any child care facility, school, church, or by any business or entity that is located within 1,000 feet of the same. **No sexually dangerous predator shall be Employed or Volunteer (Added July 01, 2008)** at any business or entity that is located within 1,000 feet of any child care facility, school, church, or area where minors congregate to include public and private parks, recreation facilities, playgrounds, skating rinks, neighborhood centers, gymnasiums, beaches or public and community swimming pools.
6. A sex offender that claims he or she is exempt from such prohibition pursuant to subsection (**40-1-15 f**) shall provide sufficient proof demonstrating his or her exemption to the sheriff of the county where sex offender is registered within **10 (ten) days** of being notified of such violation(**42-1-15 g**).
